Early Childhood Screening:

The screening is free of charge and children are **required** to have had an early childhood screening done prior to entering kindergarten.

This class requires the student to complete 30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind the wheel instruction. These hours are mandated by law if a student under the age of 18 is to acquire a Driver's Permit or License.

- Students will learn to evaluate their own work.

Students may use community service completed through school or students may arrange individual service opportunities with community agencies of their choice. Questions regarding whether or not something qualifies as service may be directed to the LCWM Community Education office.

Student Requirements:

- 100 hours of community service per year. Half of those hours (50) must be with the same entity/organization.
- Two recommendations from agencies or individuals served that describe the volunteer work completed and the student's attitude and competence.
- A digital photo of them doing service or a photo that represents their service experience.
- Reflection paper this is an opportunity for students to reflect on their service and share their service experience with others.
- Chemical Free students will be chemicalfree and verify that to be true on the application.


